Submission Guidelines

- Performances can involve just one student, a whole team, multiple teams and even teachers! Friends and other classmates may also participate if they will be present at the Japan Bowl.
- The winning talent will get to perform at the 2012 National Japan Bowl as well as at the Sakura Matsuri on April 14th.

Entry Process

- Send the Japan-America Society of Washington DC a video showing your talent performance along with the submission form to enter.

Deadline: January 20, 2012

- A selection committee appointed by the Japan-America Society of Washington, DC will decide the winners of the contest.
- The winner(s) will get to perform at the National Japan Bowl, Sakura Matsuri, and receive a special prize (TBA).
