Prep for JLPT* Grade 1 & 2 TUES 7:00-8:30pm	This class is designed for people who plan to take 2007 JLPT Grade 1 or 2. The actual test from 2005 will also be used to familiarize you with the test format and questions. This class also uses supplemental materials in addition to the required two textbooks. (1) Shiken ni deru Kanji to Goi & (2) Shiken ni deru Bunpo to Hyogen (\$55 total)

Deadline: Wednesday, 9/12/07. Payment must be received by this date. \$25 non-refundable late fee after the deadline.

Tuition: \$180 for members; \$250 for non-members. There is no prorated tuition. Should you be absent, there will be no make-up classes or refunds, and you are responsible for the class you missed. We do not offer private tutoring.

Membership: \$25 full time undergraduate students (23 years or younger); \$40 senior citizens, \$60 individual; \$80 family; \$150 sustaining. *Membership is not required to register.*

Textbooks: All textbooks and workbooks may be purchased before or on the first day of class. See above for prices.

Tuition Refunds: Requests must be received in writing following cancellation by phone: By 9/21/07 for full refund; from 9/22/07 to 10/5/07 for 50% refund. No refund after 10/6/07. There is no credit for unattended classes. Textbooks can not be returned once purchased.

Registration Confirmation: Confirmation letters will be mailed or faxed by 9/19/07.

Class Levels: If you wish, stop by JASW between 9:30am-5:00pm (M-F) to look at textbooks and to decide a class to register.

Class Size and Cancellation: Classes have a maximum of 12 students. If a class has fewer than 5 registrations, it will be cancelled. If this happens, you may transfer to another class as long as space is available or receive a refund before the semester begins.

To change your class after the semester starts, you may do so as long as there is space available in the chosen class. Any changes must be approved by JASW in advance. A letter of class completion will be issued upon request only when a student's attendance is 60% or higher. If a student is under 17, an adult must accompany them to and from class.
