Levels of Competition and Speech Criteria

BEGINNER

Must currently be enrolled in 1st level Japanese; must not have resided in Japan for more than 3 months.

Speech: 2-4 minutes

INTERMEDIATE

Must currently be enrolled in 2nd level Japanese; must not have resided in Japan for more than 6 months

Speech: 3-5 minutes

ADVANCED

Must currently be enrolled in 3rd level (or higher level) Japanese; must not have resided in Japan for more than 1 year.

Speech: 4-6 minutes

Judging Criteria: CONTENT, ORGANIZATION, LANGUAGE, DELIVERY, MEMORIZATION
Speeches must be the original work of the speaker. Any topic is acceptable.
